













The appeal of Palladian villas

Located in the Province of Treviso in Northern Italy not far from Venice, Maser is a little treasure nestling in gently rolling hills, dotted with ancient churches and patrician villas. It is the neoclassical Palladian architecture of these villas that was the inspiration for this collection whose harmonious lines speak of understated elegance, bordering on the austere.









Mediaeval inspiration

A Tuscan town with an extraordinary historical and artistic heritage, Siena is most famous for its Palio, a re-enactment of history dating back to the 17th Century, in which ten contrade, or local districts, challenge each other on horseback. However, it is the mediaeval legacy, still recognisable almost everywhere in the urban landscape that was the inspiration for this collection.















Isle of dreams

One of the most magical spots in Campania, the limestone Isle of Capri is just off the coast of Naples, surrounded by the deep blue sea from which emerge the famous Faraglioni islets, jagged rock formations like fingers pointing at the sky. The rounded curves of the collection that bears this island's name draw their inspiration from the vaulted roofs of traditional Capri dwellings.











Artisan style

Retirement home of the famous actress Eleonora Duse, Asolo in the province of Treviso, is a little fortress town surrounded by sturdy walls radiating out from the Rocca, the 12th Century castle. Asolo is not only legendary for its beauty and unique brand of hospitality, but also for its ancient crafts whose traditions are still lovingly preserved. This collection celebrates that elegant artisan style of yesteryear.

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
